

## CHILDREN S ACTIVITIES

	BEGINNER 2 (BegII)	Able to play tunes and know a few chords
	INTERMEDIATE (Int)	Plays many tunes from memory beginning to arrange and embellish
	ADVANCED (Adv)	Confident embellishing, solid understanding of chords

- # Please arrive at workshops with instruments already in tune!
- # Unless the workshop leader requests otherwise, feel free to bring a tape recorder to help with practicing later, and feel free to observe any workshop, even if you don t bring an instrument.
- # Some workshops are able to accommodate a limited number of participants. If you choose one of these workshops and it is full, please respect the limit and choose another workshop.
- # No smoking in workshops or workshop areas!
- # **You are responsible for bringing your own chair or stool.** Very few areas have seating.
- # Please be considerate of others. If you bring a stand-up stand, be sure that you aren t blocking the view of others who are seated. If you aren t attending a workshop, **do not leave your instrument unattended** as a way of place-holding for a later class. Be very careful of other people s instruments. Spilled food and drinks can cause a disaster.
- # Special ONE-ON-ONE workshops will be held **Thursday, Friday and Saturday in Area 3 at 10:00** for those with little or no experience. **Volunteers are needed!** You don t need to be an expert to share the basics with someone else. Please come and, if possible, bring your instrument so you can demonstrate on it.
- # There will be workshops on **Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday at 1:00 in the Area 3** to prepare for the All Hammered Dulcimer Pre-Show 20,001+ String Dulcimer Band.
